GENERAL REGISTRATION CONDITIONS FOR PUPILS IN THE MUSIC WORKSHOP DURING SCHOOL HOLIDAYS

1) Registration deadline:

Inscription are open as long as the dates are available on the form on our website.

2) General payment information

No refund will be made

-There is no workshop cancellation

The workshop can be postponed without any explanation to one of the following two workshops if the parents inform the school administration at least 48 hours in advance.

-If the child falls ill the day before, the workshop can be postponed to one of the following two workshops on presentation of a medical certificate within 48 hours.

Without a medical certificate, there is no postponement of the workshop.

-If the child falls ill during the workshop, there is no postponement of the workshop or reimbursement.

3) Insurance: Ethias insurance covers accidents during the practice of activities.

4) Practical information:

- The maximum number of children per group vary with the laws.
- \bullet From Monday to Friday 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.
- Possible registration ONLY for 5 full days
- Parents will not be allowed in the school building
- The concert at the end of the course will be recorded and the parents will receive it by email
- The school has a garden: children can spend most of the day outside
- A change of teacher is the exclusive responsibility of the management of the BRIMA school without it being required to notify the students beforehand. The only obligation of the school is the constant maintenance of the quality of teaching by high-level teachers.
- Meeting with the teachers: you can meet the teachers between 8:30 am and 8:45 am, or between 5:15 pm and 5:30 pm.
- Meals: children must bring their own meals; we have microwave to reheat if necessary or the freezer to keep cold
- Snacks: juice and water, biscuits and waffles are provided by the music school and are available to children
- •Nap: we are equipped so that children can take a nap if necessary
- Language spoken during the workshop: French
- If the teacher perceives symptoms of illness or discomfort in a child during lessons, the teacher will quickly contact the parents by telephone so that they can pick up their child as soon as possible. Sick children will not be able to participate in activities.
- 5) Diapers are not allowed during the workshops, the child with diaper will not be allowed at the workshop. If you realized your child needs to use diaper, you've up to 3 days after the registration is submitted (minimum 3 days before the workshop begins) to inform us and request for a refund. After that, no reimbursement is possible.
- 6) Any dispute relating to these general conditions, given to the student or to one of his parents or guardian, and signed for formal agreement, is within the jurisdiction of the courts of 1st Instance of the judicial district of Brussels in French and, in particular, if the amounts disputed are greater than €1,860, that of the Justice of the Peace of Woluwe (Av Grandchamps, 147 1150 Brussels).
